

## BEST 648 AWD Assembly

Thank you for your recent purchase. If you are not mechanically inclined we highly suggest letting your local bike shop assemble so that the brakes and fit is to your liking. (usually \$30 or less) Once you remove the bike from the box please follow the following instructions:

1. Remove packing materials **carefully** from the handlebars/wires that are in the hanging position. Turn stem to proper riding position and tighten with allen wrench included. Place handlebars in stem position to your liking and tighten.
2. If you are going to use front fender attached with screws and bolts provided. Otherwise, place front wheel into fork and tighten bolts. Once front wheel is tightened plug front wheel wire into cable.
3. Install right pedal by turning right and left pedal by turning left.
4. Remove packaging from seat and seat post and place in seat tube at proper height level for rider. Then close the latch to tighten.
5. Open the enclosed box to find the battery charger. Position the bike near an electrical outlet. Turn the key in the battery to the off position. To charge the battery connect the charger cord to the battery first then place the power cord into a outlet. You will see a red light on charger showing it is charging. When the light turns green the battery is fully charged.(approx. 4 hours on an empty battery)

This bike has been pre-checked for safety. Please double check all bolts for the fenders, lights front wheel etc. as shipping can cause parts to loosen and need adjustments. It is a good habit to develop a relationship with your local bike shop mechanic to help you with any issues that may come up.

To ride the bike push the center button between the up and down button on the LCD display. When the display lights up the bike is ready to go. The bike has both pedal assist and throttle. It is good to experiment with both. Pedal assist level 1 will provide the least amount of assist along with the throttle giving the least amount of throttle power. Pedal assist 3 will provide the most amount of assist and the throttle will provide the most throttle power in this level. The red switch on the right of handlebars determine the AWD. Left and right control the front and back wheel. *For optimum performance we suggest pedal assist 3 and keeping the button in the center position to have All Wheel Drive and maximum power and keep the shifter in gear 7.*
